Eligible activity:

- Support for new business start-ups
- · Projects which encourage innovation and help existing businesses to grow
- Projects which strengthen the supply chain
- Projects which make the best use of underutilised assets, e.g. redundant buildings to provide affordable workspace
- Construction costs or establishment costs for workshops, factories, premises and facilities
- Purchase of equipment and machinery
- Processing and marketing of agricultural and non-agricultural products
- Developing crafts activities

Available funding:

Minimum grant approximately £10,000. Maximum grant approximately £150,000

Grant intervention rate:

Maximum 40% of the total project's eligible costs. Grant payments are paid in arrears and therefore applicants need to demonstrate that they have sufficient funds to bankroll the project until grant payments are received. Reimbursement of grant claims are usually paid quarterly.

Who can apply?:

All types of business can apply, including social enterprises, rural based micro and small businesses, people who want to start a business in a rural area that will employ people and / or farm businesses that want to diversify.
